



LESSON SNAPSHOT

BOTTOM LINE:

Jesus died for you!

OBJECTIVE:

Kids will learn that Jesus' love knows no bounds or limits. Jesus died for me!

KEY PASSAGE:

Mark 15:16-20, The Crown of Thorns (Egg 7: Crown of Thorns)

Luke 23:26-28, 32-43, The Cross (Egg 8: Cross)

John 19:30-34, The Death of Jesus (Egg 9: Spear)

MEMORY VERSE:

*"Anyone who believes in Christ is a new creation. The old is gone! The new has come!"
-2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIRV)*

SUMMARY:

In week 3, kids will see the fullness of Jesus' love. Jesus endured death on the cross for all of us: the soldiers who mocked him, the disciples that turned away, and the criminals beside him. Jesus died for every single one of them. . . for every single one of us. For this week's activity, kids will have a powerful visual reminder as they attach their own name to a cross as a reminder that Jesus died for their sins.

Thank you for sending Jesus to die for us.

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV)

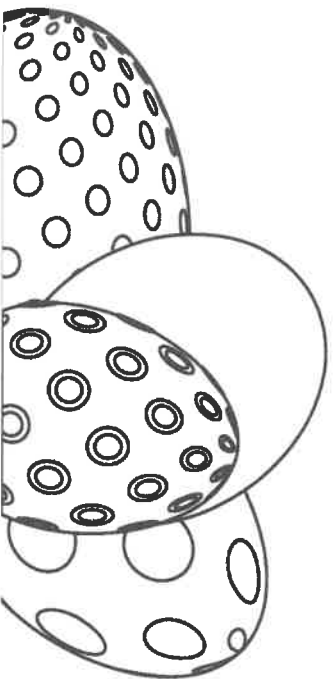
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LARGE GROUP:

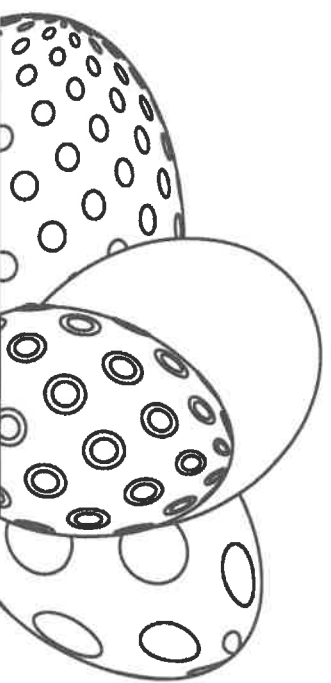
Choose three kids from the audience. Have each one "sing" the memory verse in a different musical style - country, hip-hop, oldies, opera, etc.

SMALL GROUP:

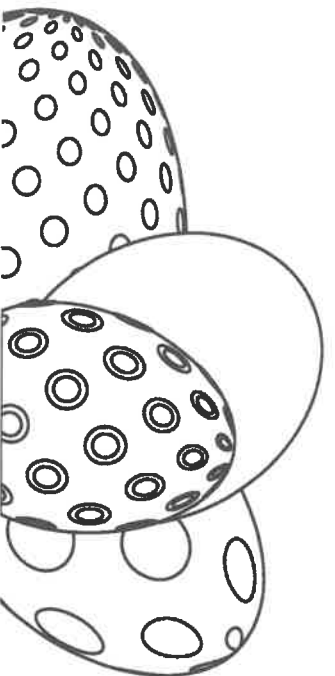
Have the kids collaborate on a musical version of the Bible verse. Can it be sung to a popular tune, or can you invent your own?



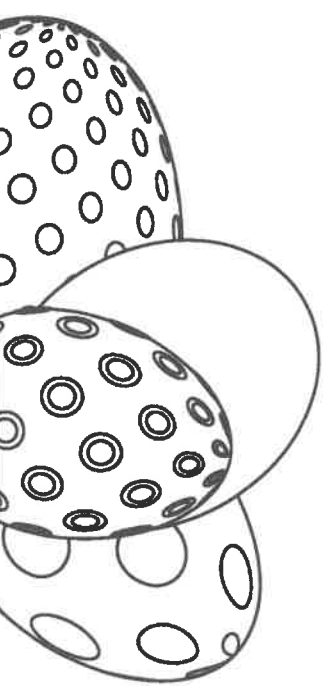
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CRAFT ACTIVITY

For a simpler alternative you can have kids color the included 3 resurrection eggs coloring pages to go along with this week's lesson.

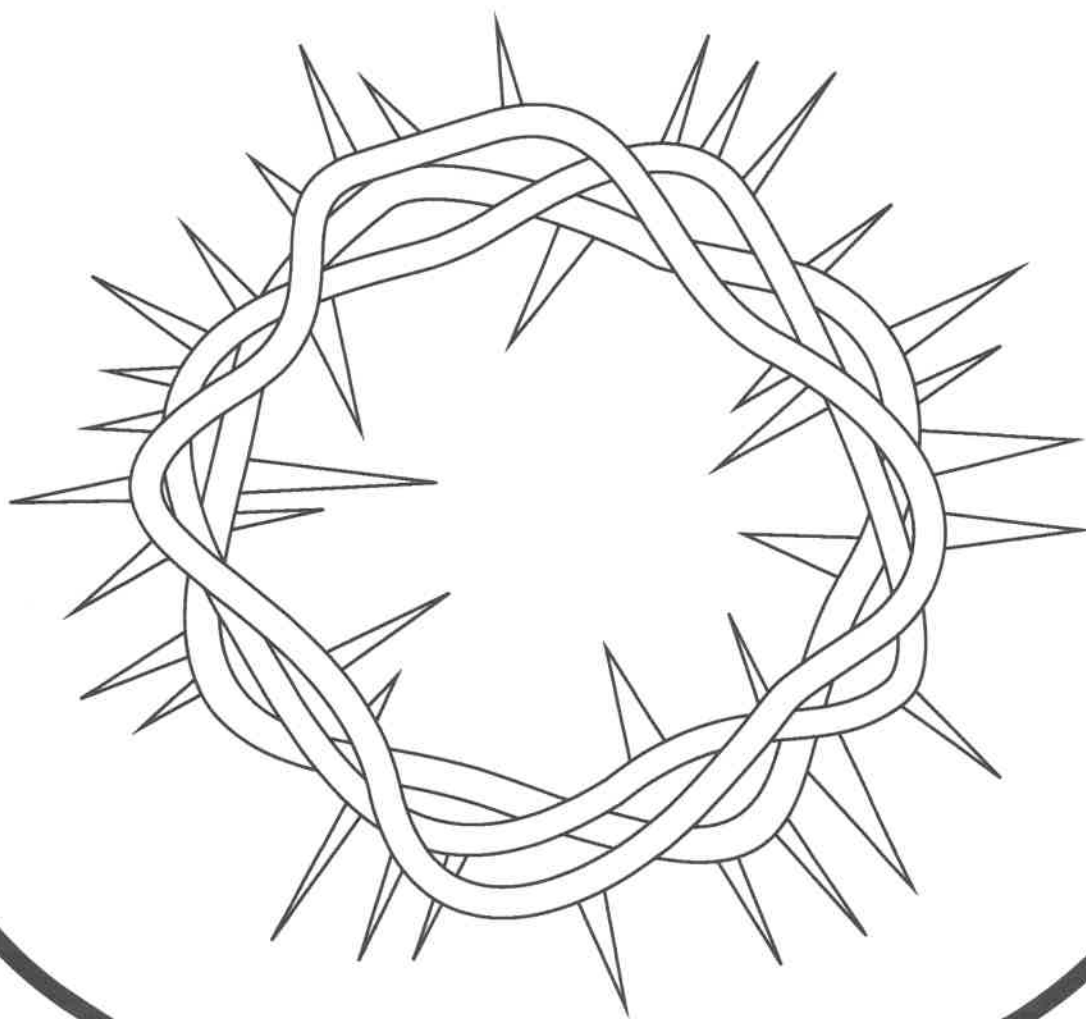

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: EGGS-TRAORDINARY LOVE



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Jesus endured death on the cross for all of us: the soldiers who mocked him, the disciples that turned away, and the criminals beside him. Jesus died for every single one of them. . . for every single one of us.

HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your child to show you the eggs they made in church this week and explain what they represent from the Easter story.

- How do we know Jesus loves us too?
